



International Congress on Electrical Distribution Cidel Argentina 2026

GUIDE FOR SUBMITTING ABSTRACTS

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this document is to guide authors in the presentation of papers for Cidel Argentina 2026.

2. CONTENIDO

The documents may be submitted in one of the following languages: Spanish, English, or Portuguese, according to the attached template.

The article must consist of the following parts:

a) Identification sheet (1st page, attached model) containing:

- Document title, main author's name, country and email: Other author and co-author data are entered into the Capitol system on the web.

- Keywords: Between 3 and 5 keywords should be included, selected to best characterize the document and facilitate its bibliographic categorization.
- Abstract: A brief summary of no more than 500 words that guides the reader through the content of the work, highlighting the main points developed within it. Once the abstract is approved, the authors will receive instructions for submitting the full paper.

b) Document Body: The document body should include an introduction, text, and conclusions. It is recommended to follow these guidelines:





- Introduction: The author defines or develops their thesis, experience, or study in general terms, indicating its order and with a brief reference to the conclusions.
 - Text: The author presents or develops their thesis, experience, or study, providing the necessary details for a thorough understanding of the work. They refer to the materials, equipment, methods, and procedures used and give a detailed description of the subject.
 - Conclusions: In the final part of the text, the conclusions drawn from the work are stated and recommendations may be included.
- c) Annexes or Appendices: These are supplementary elements that follow the main text and complement some of its aspects. For example, graphs, charts, tables, etc., which, due to their content or format, are not included in the body of the work so as not to disrupt the flow of the text.
- d) Bibliography: The bibliography should contain the bibliographic references that the author consulted for their work.

3. NORMAS

- Font: Arial or Times New Roman 10.
- Paragraph: 1 cm (5 characters).
- Page: A4 size, with a top margin of 3.5 cm, a bottom margin of 2 cm, a left margin of 3 cm, and a right margin of 2 cm.
- Page numbers should be centered and placed 1 cm from the bottom edge of the page.
- Equations: Equations should be placed 5 spaces after the left margin and identified by consecutive numbers in parentheses on the right margin of the line.





- Units of Measurement: The text must use units of the International System of Units (SI). When other units are used (e.g., English units), they must be expressed after the SI units in parentheses.
- Table and Figure Titles: Table and figure titles should be placed above and below the table and figure, respectively, using Arabic numerals separated by hyphens, with initial capital letters.
- Page Limit: For summary 2 (two), maximum 500 words.
